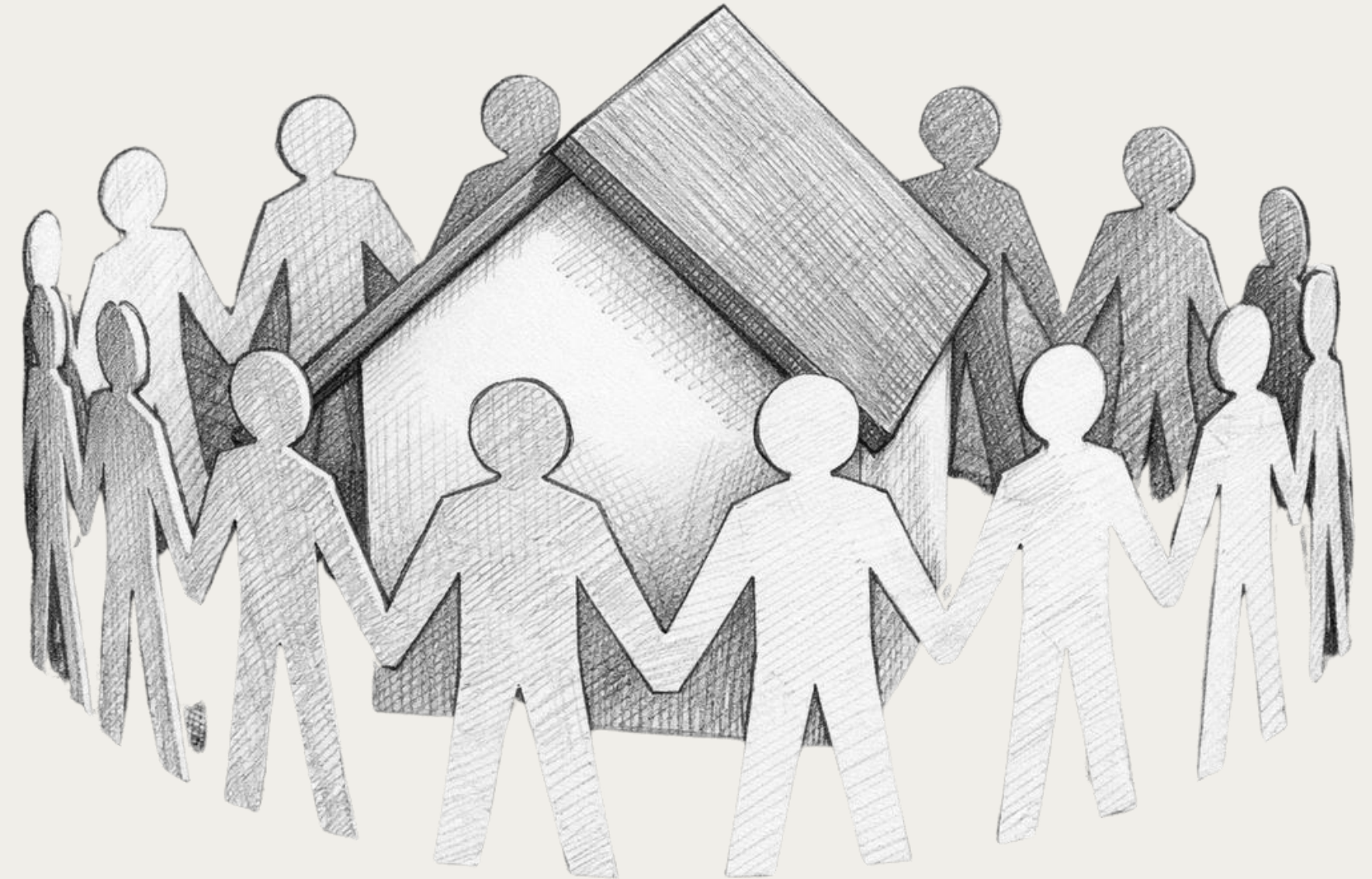

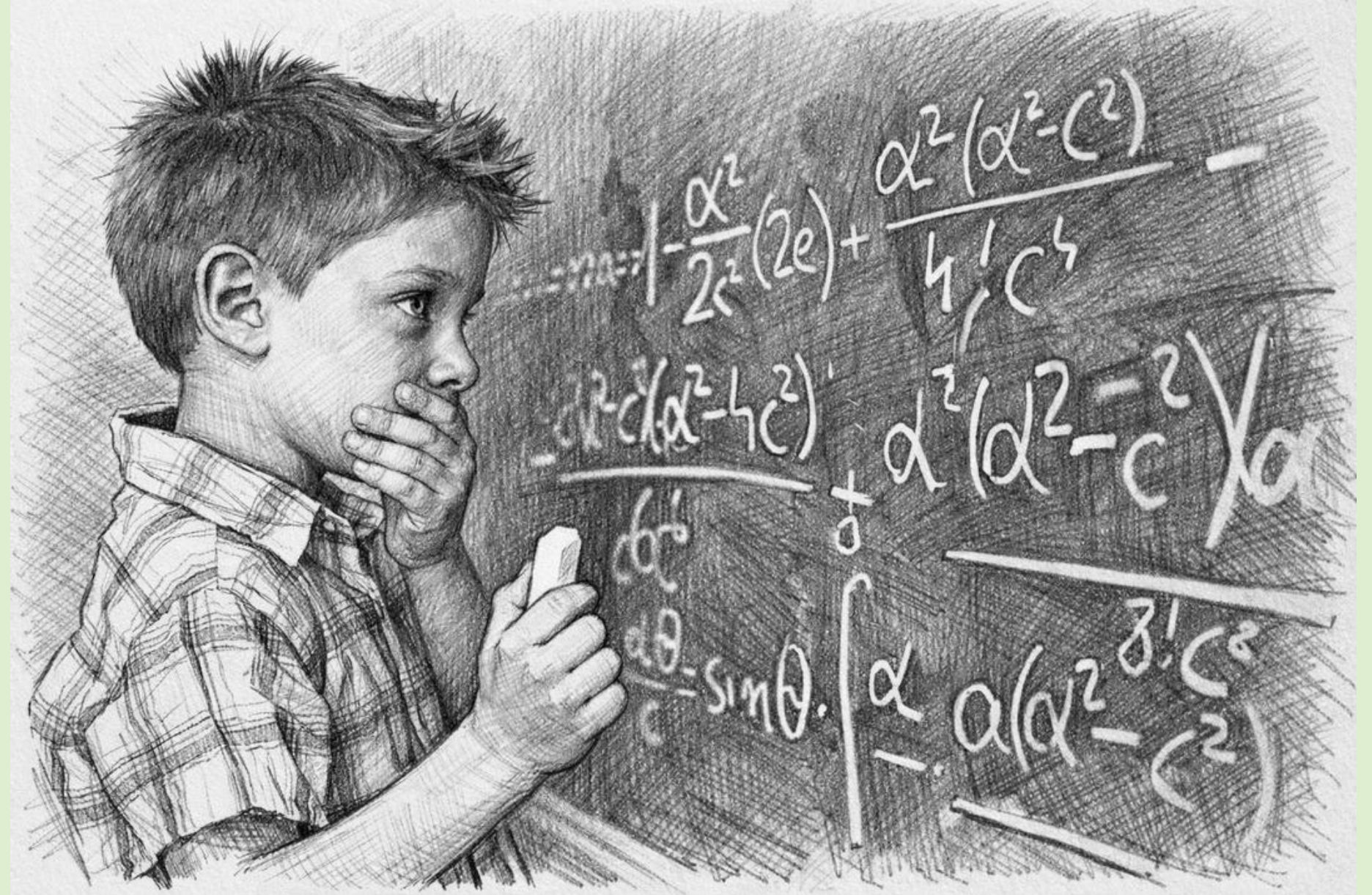

- Balance of account at the end of the last financial year, £862.30
- Applied for community grant in March 2025 of £950 which we received. Thank you to Councillor Afzaal Kiani for his support.

# TREASURER'S REPORT

- How we have used the monies in 2025 and going forward:
  - Community events such as Wreath Making, Yard Sale, Litter Picks, Knit & Natter, our AGM and Steering and Planning Groups.
  - Producing our first community newsletter.
  - Updates for our website.
  - Purchasing litter pickers, bibs, a new outdoor PA system and the replacement of broken gazebos.
  - Monies were also used for dog fouling posters, marketing, flyers, plus food and refreshments such as we have laid on today.

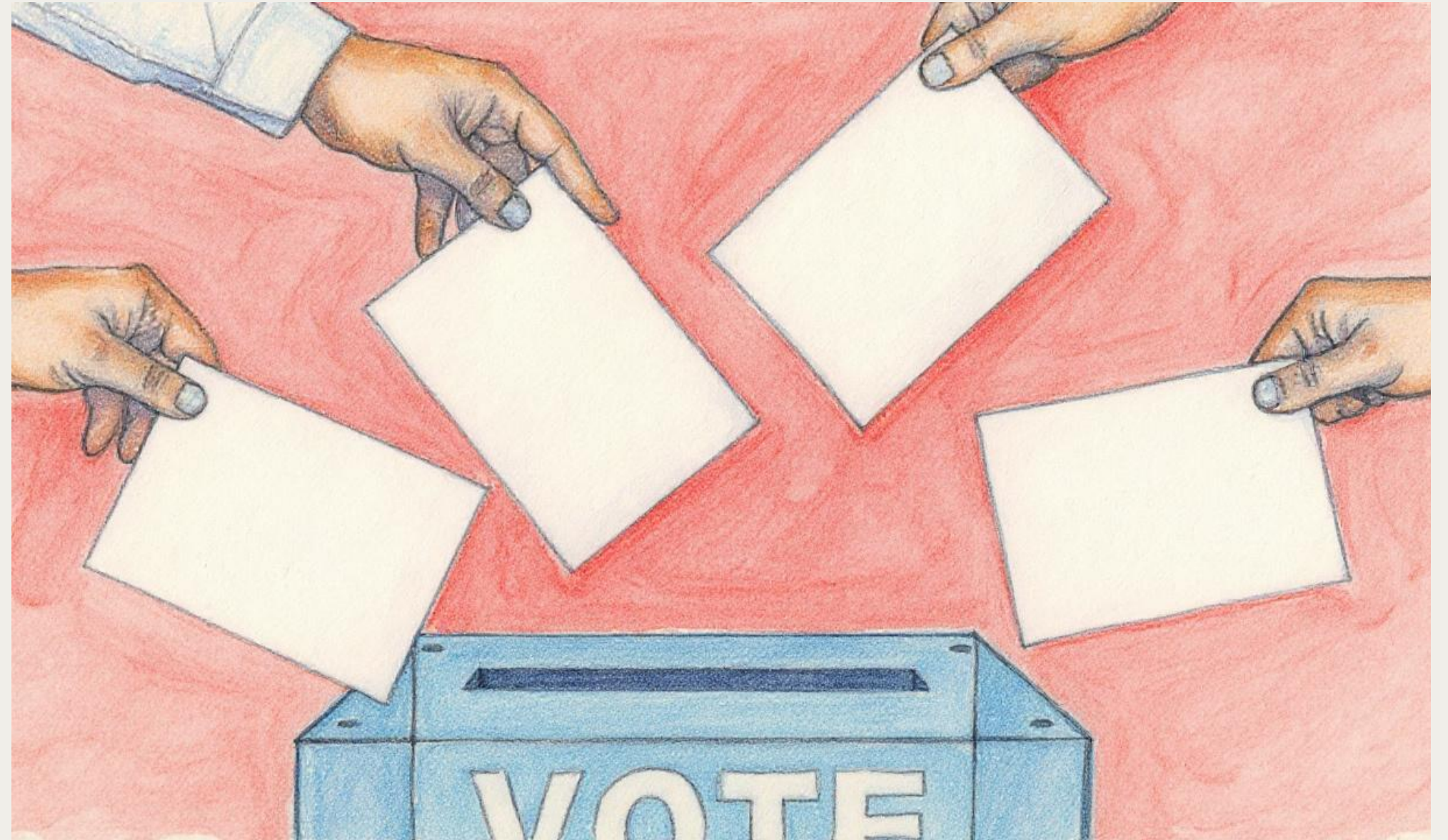
# SOCIAL SUMMARY: WREATH MAKING
